1. INVITATION FOR BID

1.1 Introduction

1.1.1 Emergency Response Support System (ERSS) is the vision of the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), Govt. of India, to launch the implementation of a nationwide, unified emergency response system with catering to a single emergency telephone number 112. ERSS is a unique system which provides 112 emergency services in a fast and efficient way. Govt. of India has allotted 112 as the single number for all emergency services in the country which includes police, fire, medical, disaster, coastal services etc. Once the integrated 112 system matures, all other emergency numbers in the country will be withdrawn in a phased manner. Citizens of India can now call a single Pan India number 112 for any emergency. The States/UTs where the ERSS has been launched are Andhra Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, UP, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, Punducherry, Lakshadweep, Andaman, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu, Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Nagaland. Uttarakhand State initiated the scheme “Extension of Emergency Response Support System (ERSS) (Dial 112) for Disaster Emergencies” and integrated with the SEOCs in 2021. The MOU was signed between NDMA Government of India and USDMA for the project for ERSS (Dial 112).

1.1.2 USDMA, Dehradun intends SELECTION OF AGENCY FOR SUPPLY OF MANPOWER FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE SUPPORT SYSTEM (ERSS) SCHEME FUNDED BY NDMA FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR WHICH SHALL BE EXTENDED FOR ONE YEAR ON MUTUALLY AGREED TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER e-PROCUREMENT SYSTEM, in Uttarakhand, India.

1.1.3 A “Single Stage, Two Envelope” bidding process has been planned for determining the Successful Bidder on L₁ basis. The Bidders would be required to meet the minimum threshold Technical Qualification Conditions and qualify for undertaking the Project as set out in this Tender document. This qualification assessment would be carried out as part of the current bidding and evaluation process. The Financial Bids of only those Bidders that possess the minimum Technical Qualification Conditions and other relevant documents would be opened and evaluated.

1.1.4 The Tender document contains information about the Project/Work, bidding process, Bid submission, qualification and Financial Bid requirement.

2. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR BID SUBMISSION AND BID EVALUATION.

2.1 Instructions for Online Bid Submission

1. The online procurement portal is <http://uktenders.gov.in>.
2. Possession of valid Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) and enrolment/registration of the contractors/bidders on the e-Procurement/e-tender portal are prerequisite for e-tendering.
3. Bidder should register for the enrolment in the e-Procurement site using the “Online Bidder Enrolment” option available on the home page. Portal enrolment is generally free of charge. During enrolment/registration, the bidders should provide only valid and true information including valid email id. All the correspondence shall be made directly with the contractors/bidders through email id as registered.
4. Bidder need to login to the site through their user ID/ password chosen during enrolment/registration.
5. Then the Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by SIFY/TCS/ nCode/ eMudra or any other Certifying Authority recognized by Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) India on eToken /Smart Card, should be registered.
6. The registered DSC only should be used by the bidder in the transactions and should ensure safety of the same.
7. Contractor/Bidder may go through the tenders published on the site and download the tender documents/schedules for the tenders.
8. After downloading/getting the tender document/schedules, the Bidder should go through them carefully and then submit the documents as required, otherwise bid will be rejected.
9. Any clarifications may be sought online through the tender site, through the contact details or during pre- bid meeting, if any. Bidder should take into account the corrigendum, if any published before submitting the bids online.
10. Bidder may log in to the site through the secured login by the user id/password chosen during enrolment/registration and then by submitting the password of the e- Token/Smartcard to access DSC.
11. Bidder may select the tender in which he/she is interested in by using the search option and then move it to the ‘my tenders’ folder.
12. From my tender folder, he may select the tender to view all the details uploaded there.
13. It shall be deemed that the bidder has read and understood all the terms and conditions before submitting the offer. Bidder should go through the tender schedules carefully and upload the documents as asked; otherwise, the incomplete bid shall stand rejected.
14. Bidder should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document/schedule in advance and ordinarily it shall be in PDF/xls/rar/jpg/dwf formats. If there is more than one document, all may be clubbed together and provided in the requested format. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option. It is advisable that each document to be uploaded through online for the tenders should be less than 2 MB. If any document is more than 2MB, it can be reduced through zip/ rar and the same, if permitted may be uploaded. The file size being less than 1 MB the transaction uploading time will be very fast.
15. The Bidders can update well in advance, the documents such as certificates, annual report details etc., under “My Space option” and these can be selected as per tender requirements and then send along with bid documents during bid submission. This will facilitate the bid submission process faster by reducing upload time of bids.
16. Bidder should submit the Tender Fees and Bid Security as specified in the tender. The hard copy should be posted/couriered/given in person to the Tender Inviting Authority, within bid submission due date and time as indicated in the tender. Scanned copy of the instrument should be uploaded as part of the offer & affidavit as stated in the Tender Document. Any delay for submission of these documents

bidder will be responsible

17. While submitting the bids online, the bidder shall read the terms and conditions and may accept the same to proceed further to submit the bid packets.

18. The bidder has to select the payment option as offline to pay the Bid Security as applicable and enter details of the instruments.

19. The details of the DD/any other accepted instrument, physically delivered, should tally with the details available in the scanned copy and the data entered during bid submission time, otherwise submitted bid shall not be acceptable or liable for rejection.

20. The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated. The very act of using DSC for downloading the bids and uploading their offers shall be deemed to be a confirmation that they have duly read, understood and agreed with all clauses of the bid document without any exception.

21. The bidder has to upload the relevant files required as indicated in the cover content. In case of any irrelevant files, the bid may be rejected.

22. If the price bid format is provided in a spread sheet file like BoQ_MP.xls, the rates offered should be entered in the allotted space only and uploaded after filling the relevant columns. The Priced-bid/BOQ template shall not be modified /replaced by the bidder; else the bid submitted is liable to be rejected for the tender.

23. The bidders are advised to submit the bids through online e-tendering system to the Tender Inviting Authority well before the bid submission due date and time (as per Server System Clock). The Authority shall not be held responsible for any delay or the difficulties faced during the submission of bids online by the bidders.

24. After the bid submission (i.e. after Clicking "Freeze Bid Submission" in the portal), the acknowledgement number indicated by the system should be printed by the bidder and kept as a record of evidence for online submission of bid for the particular tender and also be used as entry pass to participate in the bid opening.

25. The time settings fixed in the server side and displayed at the top of the tender site, shall remain valid for all actions of requesting, bid submission, bid opening etc., in the e-Tender system. The bidders should follow such time during bid submission.

26. All the data being entered by the bidders would be encrypted using Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered is not retrievable by unauthorized persons during the bid submission and until the time of bid opening by any person.

27. Any bid document that is uploaded to the server is subjected to symmetric encryption using a system generated symmetric key. Further this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers/bid openers' public keys. Overall, the uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.

28. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained with the use of Secured Socket Layer (SSL) 128 bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done.

29. The bidder should logout of the tendering system using the normal logout option available at the top right hand corner and not by selecting the (X) exit option in the browser.

3. The evaluation of the Bids will be completed in 3 Steps

A. Step 1 – Opening & Evaluation of Original Documents [Submitted in Hard Copy(s)] i.e. Tender Document Fees, EMD/Bid Security and Affidavit for Correctness of Bid.

B. Step 2 – Opening of Technical Bids and Technical Evaluation.

C. Step 3 – Opening of Financial Bids of technically qualified bidders

Note: The minimum technical marks to qualify for bidders is 70 out of 100.

3.1.1. Amongst all the proposals, the proposal that score higher than the minimum technical score, the proposal with the lowest financial quote will be considered as the Most Advantageous Proposal.

3.1.2. The Successful Bidder (substantially responsive L1 Bidder) shall be issued Letter of Award (LoA). After issuance of the LoA in writing and acceptance of the same by the Successful Bidder within 7 (seven) days from the date of receipt of Letter of Award (LOA). An amount equivalent to 5% of total work order value has to be deposited by the Successful Bidder, which will be retain as a Performance Security and shall be released after successfully completion of work as per Agreement.

4. Technical Qualification Conditions

The Bidder shall submit the following additional documents in the Technical Bid and accordingly the bids will be evaluated on the basis of the documents submitted. Bidders are requested to refer to the Technical Eligibility Criteria for Technical Qualification Condition.

- 4.1. The Bidder should be a Company / Partnership firm / Society / Proprietorship Firm.
- 4.2. The following details shall also be provided by Bidders:
 - a) Name, address, and ward/circle
 - b) Company's PAN
 - c) Company's GST
 - d) Certification of incorporation.
 - e) Registration details of the company under applicable taxes
 - f) Power of Attorney of the authorized person**
- 4.3. The Bidder Should be in the Human Resource Business or having qualification and experience in the field of Human Resource. The Bidder should having at least 3 years of experience of providing manpower as mentioned in Schedule of Requirements in **Central Govt./State Govt./PSUs/Autonomous Bodies/Universities/ Banks** in related field (the experience in the field of security services is not considerable). The Bidder shall submit successfully completion certificate from the end user/ client.
- 4.4. The bidder shall submit an affidavit duly attested by Notary Public/Oath Commissioner to the effect that the service provider has neither been blacklisted nor debarred by any authority.

Note: The information and documents in support of meeting the qualification criteria as specified above should be uploaded in Technical Bid.

5. Financial Evaluation & Selection of L1 Bidder

The financial evaluation will be based on the amount quoted by the bidder as monthly remuneration, inclusive of EPF, ESI, Service Charge, and other applicable costs.

Maximum Ceiling for Monthly Remuneration

- Supervisor: ₹ 21,000 (excluding GST)
- Operator: ₹ 18,000 (excluding GST)

Bidders quoting more than the fixed ceiling of monthly remuneration without GST will be declared non-responsive.

Minimum Salary Requirements

The minimum salary to be offered to Supervisor and Operator should not be less than the Minimum Wages for Skilled Category as per the Minimum Wages Act issued by the Uttarakhand Government.

Note 1:

- Service charges should not be less than 3.85 %.
- In case two or more bidders quoted the same price, then the selection will be based on the firm having Highest Average Annual turnover in last 3 F.Y.(s) and registered in Uttarakhand,
- **The Employer's decision shall be final and binding on all Bidders.**

6. Other Terms & Conditions

6.1 The Bid of any Bidder who has not complied with one or more of the conditions prescribed in the terms & conditions/minimum technical parameter will be summarily rejected.

6.2 The successful bidder shall pay the minimum rate of wages as per Central Sphere – Ministry of Labour and Employment to the deployed manpower.

6.3 USDMA reserves the right to increase or decrease the scope of work without assigning any reason and shift employee/employees anywhere according to requirement of work.

6.4 USDMA will reimburse the wages & other statutory charges and no advance payment will be allowed to the successful bidder.

6.5 USDMA will provide the monthly attendance details of deployed manpower and the contractor shall submit bill along with attendance. On the basis of bill, contractor shall pay the wages, ESI and EPF to each employee. After transferring the monthly wages, EPF and ESI to his deployed manpower, contractor shall submit the related document to this office with pay bill, EPF and ESI Details as a proof.

6.6 The bidder shall be capable to pay the wages as per tender document timely before 05th of every month from his own resources.

6.7 The bidder shall be capable to pay monthly wages up to 3 - 4 months from his own resources in case of delay in payment by USDMA due to unavoidable circumstances.

6.8 The deployed manpower may be the employee / contractual employee of the bidder firm but they cannot be employee of USDMA Office.

6.9 The Bidder shall be liable for any issues arising in relation to EPF, ESI and shall deal with it taking responsibility of the related procedures.

6.10 Requisite manpower shall be provided within 15 days from the final contract signing.

6.11 The deployed manpower has to work from Monday to Saturday during office hours. However, the deployed manpower has to work extra as and when required by USDMA.

6.12 Deployed manpower may be the employee/ contractual employees of the Bidder's firm but they cannot be employee or servant of USDMA office.

6.13 The prices shall be firm and shall not be subjected to any adjustment during the complete contractual completion period. However, the requirement of the manpower can be increased or decreased. In case the requirement is increased, then the variation shall be done as per the prices quoted by the successful bidder in their financial bid.

6.14 In case USDMA found that the performance of any of the deployed manpower is not satisfactory, the successful bidder shall replace him/her within 07 days after getting notice from USDMA in writing. If any employee from deployed manpower want to leave the job, the successful bidder shall inform 30 days in advance in writing and replace him/her after 30 days of notice. If any employee of deployed manpower shall leave job/USDMA without 30 days prior notice, one month salary of respective post

shall be deducted from the bill of contractor.

7. Bid Security

The Bid Security may be forfeited:

- (a) If a Bidder withdraws its bid during the period of bid validity specified by the Bidder on the Technical Bid Submission Form
- (b) If the successful Bidder fails to sign the Contract within the time specified in the Tender Document.
- (c) If the successful bidder fails to furnish the Performance Security.

8. Performance Security

Within 21 days of Letter of Award, the successful bidder shall furnish Performance Security to ACEO (Admin), USDMA, Dehradun which shall be for an amount of **5% of the contract value** and valid up to at least 60 days after the date of completion of all the performance obligations. The Performance Security shall be in the form of Demand Draft or Bank Guarantee in favor of "ACEO (Admin), USDMA, Dehradun".
